

A Report on XX Annual Conference of IAAT

The 20th Annual Conference of the Indian Association for Angiosperm Taxonomy and International Symposium on 'Taxonomy, Plant diversity and Conservation' was organized at the Department of Botany, Bharathiar University, Coimbatore, Tamil Nadu during 26 – 28 November, 2010. The Symposium was sponsored by Department of Science & Technology (New Delhi), National Biodiversity Authority (Chennai), Council of Scientific and Industrial Research (New Delhi) and International Association for Plant Taxonomy (Vienna, Austria).

The inaugural function was presided over by Dr. P. Thirumalvalavan, Registrar, Bharathiar University, Coimbatore. Prof. S. Manian, Head, Department of Botany, Bharathiar University, Coimbatore welcomed the guests. Dr. M. Sabu, Secretary, IAAT gave a brief account of history and activities of IAAT. Dr. V. S. Ramachandran, Organising Secretary, highlighted the theme of the conference. The conference was inaugurated by Dr. M. Sanjappa, Director, Botanical Survey of India, Kolkatta. In addition to the presentations by young Scientists, the conference had plenary lectures, lead lectures and invited talks by eminent taxonomists. Plenary lecture was delivered by Dr. K.N. Gandhi, and lead lectures by Prof. S.R. Yadav (Shivaji University, Kolhapur), Prof. V.S. Raju (Kakatiya University, Warangal), Dr. N. Sasidharan (Kerala Forest Research Institute, Thrissur), Prof. M.K. Janarthanam (Goa University, Goa), and Dr. A.G. Pandurangan (Tropical Botanic Garden and Research Institute, Thiruvananthapuram).

It is heartening to see an overwhelming response from taxonomic researchers across India who enthusiastically participated in the conference. More than 350 delegates attended the conference.

The conference ended with the valedictory function which was presided over by Prof. A.K. Pandey, President, IAAT. The valedictory address was delivered by Dr. N. Vijayan Nair, Director, Sugarcane Breeding Institute, Coimbatore. Best presentation awards were given to: Nilesh V. Malpure (K.S. Manilal Award: Floristics), Kannan C.S. Warrier (Rolla S.
