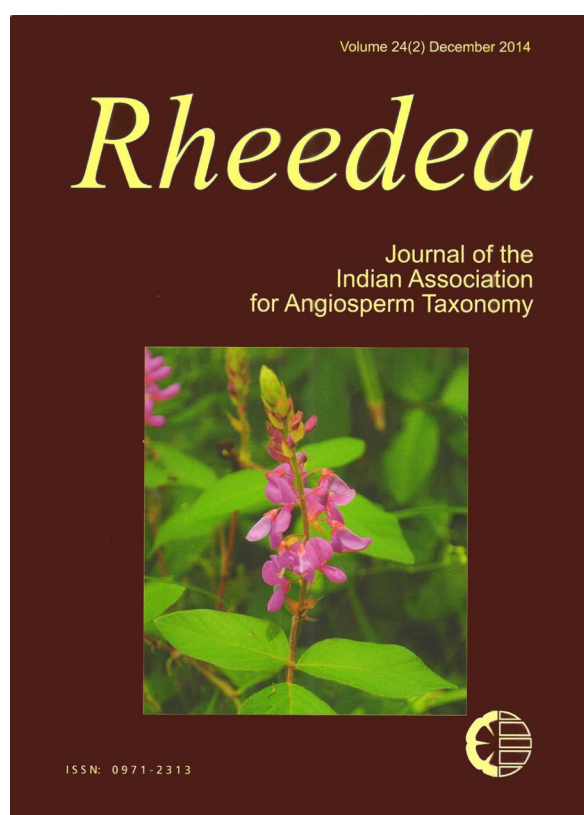

A report on XXIV Annual conference of Indian Association for Angiosperm Taxonomy (IAAT) and International Conference on Trends in Plant Systematics (TIPS)

The 24th Annual Conference of Indian Association for Angiosperm Taxonomy (IAAT) and International Conference on Trends in Plant Systematics (TIPS) was organized at the Department of Plant Science, Bharathidasan University, Tiruchirappalli, Tamil Nadu. The conference was held from 31st October to 2nd November 2014. The inaugural function was presided over by Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, Dr. V.M. Muthukumar, Bharathidasan University. Dr. Prabha Y. Themes of the Conference were Systematics of Flowering Plants and Phylogeny; Modern trends and Techniques in Plant Taxonomy; Biodiversity Assessment and Conservation; Phytogeography, Endemism and Threatened Plants; Ethnobotany; Medicinal Plants and Bioprospecting and Agrodiversity and Diversity of Stressed Habitats.
