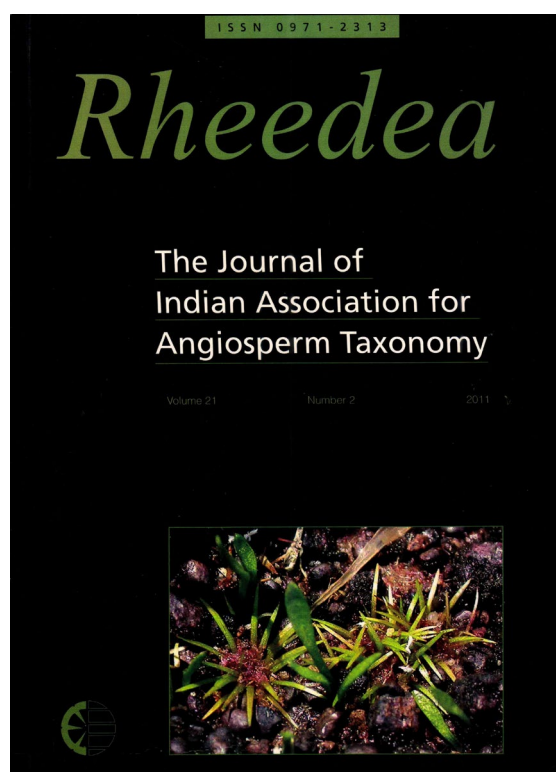

## A Report on XXII Annual Conference of IAAT and International Symposium on Innovative Prospects in Angiosperm Taxonomy (ISIPAT – 2012)

The XXII Annual Conference of IAAT and International Symposium on “Innovative Prospects in Angiosperm Taxonomy” was organized at Department of Botany, Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University, Amravati during 28 – 30 October, 2012. The inaugural function was presided over by Dr. Mohan Khedkar, Vice-Chancellor, Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University. Dr. Paramjit Singh, Director, Botanical Survey of India, Kolkata graced the occasion as Chief Guest. Dr. J.A. Tidke, Pro Vice-Chancellor of the University welcomed the guests. Dr. S.R. Manik, Professor and Head, Department of Botany and Organizing Secretary ISIPAT – 2012, introduced the theme of the Conference. Prof. A.K. Koul, President, IAAT and Dr. M. Koul, President, IAAT, focused on the enrichment of taxonomic data from allied disciplines. He expressed the view that the funding agencies have also realised the need of basic sciences like Angiosperm Taxonomy, and hoped that taxonomists utilise the opportunity and bring in innovative approaches in plant systematics.
